This apportionment, in the amount of \$17,407,249, is made from federal funds provided to the state under Title IV, Part A, Subpart 1, Student Support and Academic Enrichment, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (Public Law 114–95). Title IV, Part A, Subpart 1 funds are apportioned to eligible local educational agencies (LEAs) to increase the capacity to meet the goals of the ESEA by providing all students with access to a well-rounded education, improving school conditions for student learning, and improving use of technology in order to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students. Warrants will be mailed to each county treasurer approximately three weeks from the date of this letter.
